Objectifs pédagogiques du cours :

To provide students with an insight into the EU's action aimed at promoting the fight against economic crime through its external relations.

Contenu / descriptif du cours :

The course starts with an overview of the EU's external relations. The slow process leading to the creation of an EU foreign policy is analyzed.

The course then focuses on the institutional framework of the EU's external relations and the improvements brought about by the Lisbon treaty.

The legal instruments used in the field of external relations are then studied –mainly common positions and common actions–.

The course then analyzes the means used by the EU to foster the fight against economic crime through its external relations. Provisions aimed at fighting economic crimes featured in various agreements binding the EU to partner countries are described.

Specific fields of the EU's external relations are studied, such as enlargement and the European Neighbouring Policy.

Students will be required to carry out case studies of such agreements in order to analyze anti-economic crime provisions.
