### Programme outline

The MSc in Supply Chain Management & Purchasing provides a unique opportunity for acquiring a specialist qualification in the area of purchasing, supply chain management, combined with a generalised one in project management. This MSc programme is designed for practising professionals, mid-career managers and graduates seeking specialised training in these complementary fields at managerial level.

### Why choose this programme

- ▶ This MSc offers a dual competency in supply chain management, and purchasing & project management.
- ▶ Internationally recognised certifications are facilitated within this MSc. Certifications include preparation for the Supply Chain Apics® CPIM Part 1, PRINCE2® and Lean Six Sigma Green Belt certifications. AGILE professional certification of the APMG® is also included for the January 2019 intake.
- ▶ Collaboration with local companies who contribute to the programme design and who teach on the programme.
- ▶ International faculty, both academics and professionals teach on the programme and students come from all over the world.
- ▶ SKEMA Business School has developed many links with professional bodies at national and international level, in particular for the development of international standards and research. SKEMA is involved with: APICS®, ASLOG, Project Management Institute PMI®, APM Group (PRINCE2®).

# Programme structure

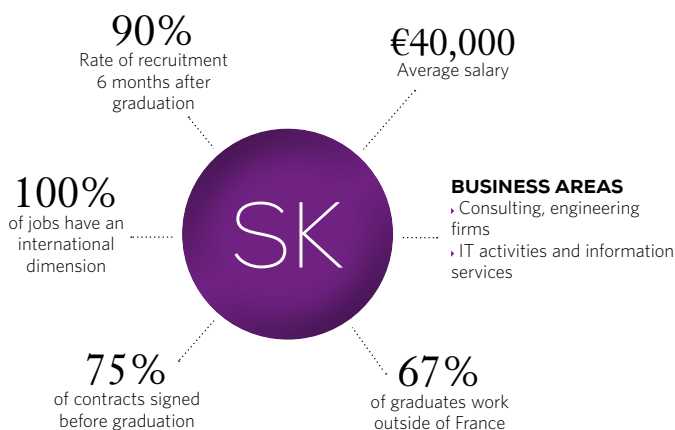
This MSc covers the whole span of supply chain activities, from planning, purchasing, receiving, production, storage to delivery through 15 compulsory courses, and four elective courses.
