Curricula

The Master 2 IDEAL is part of the Master in International Expertise at Sciences Po Aix. It is a professional master's program with a dual disciplinary foundation in economics and data, as well as in international relations from the perspective of law and political science. The courses are organized by Sciences Po Aix and the Aix Marseille School of Economics. The diploma in International Relations is awarded under the dual seal of Aix-Marseille University and the French State.

The program aims to develop an in-depth understanding of the issues involved in globalization, economic policy and diplomatic expertise, while teaching methodologies for international decision-making and action.

It combines high-level academic training in economics and international relations within a multi-disciplinary analytical framework (economics, law, management, political science), with professionalization and internationalization of students through expert appraisal or evaluation work, including international internships, reports, projects or finalized analyses, preparing students for careers in international expertise. It also offers the possibility of three months of academic mobility.

Teaching

In partnership with the Aix-Marseille School of Economics, this course, taught entirely in English, offers students the opportunity to develop their legal, diplomatic and economic knowledge in an international context, as well as training in the proficiency and use of data, with a specialization in "big data".

This specialization will enable students to develop essential skills in collecting, analyzing and interpreting quantitative data. This quantitative focus will enhance their ability to make informed decisions based on empirical data, which is particularly valuable in the fields of economics, international finance and international relations.

Students will acquire a set of versatile skills that will prepare them for the diverse challenges of international expertise.

Skills

- Keep abreast of the global geopolitical context by analyzing the issues and phenomena brought about by globalization.
- Understand the challenges of climate change, considering the profound structural changes brought about by the new international governance and their impact on states and companies.
- Understand and compare the economic, political, cultural and legal systems of nations and geographical areas
- Manage projects and crisis situations in an international and/ or multicultural environment
- Know the codes and protocols of international relations and master the workings of diplomatic expertise
- Write specifications, reports, summaries and evaluations
- Collect, analyze and interpret quantitative data

Professional opportunities

This Master's degree is designed to train students for roles involving international interfaces, auditing, evaluation and expertise, as well as operational functions.

The career opportunities both in France and abroad, particularly target private organizations, but also the public sector (in particular data analysts, research managers, consultants, etc.).
