Students will examine environmental regulation fundamentals, evaluate policy instruments like taxes and permits, and analyze various models of green economy. Specialized topics include green finance, energy and water economics, and behavioral approaches to environmental issues, providing a comprehensive understanding of the challenges and opportunities in sustainable development.
